TekFocus Awarded Dallas Business Journal 2009 Best Place to Work Honor

Dallas, TX September 17, 2009:

TekFocus was awarded the Dallas Business Journal's Best Places to Work in the Small Business Category on September 17, 2009. Over 1600 people from companies across Dallas attended the awards luncheon held at the Hotel Intercontinental.

Companies eligible for the award must have an office in North Texas and a minimum of 10 employees. Entries were given to Quantum Workplace, an independent company that conducts the Best Places to Work for a number of City Business Journals publications. In years past, the Dallas Business Journal would recognize the Top 20 Best Places to work in each category meaning many companies missed the qualification by a fraction of a percentage. This year, DBJ recognized more companies, but featured only those that ranked in the Top 20. In all, 162 companies were recognized from nearly 500 applications.

To earn the prestigious DBJ Best Places to Work designation, companies had to earn a national best practice score for their category, as determined by Quantum Workplace. 2009 was TekFocus' first year to win the award and ranked #14 out of the top 100. "We are thrilled just to be recognized along with these other great companies, but ranking #14 our first year out was very exciting" says Kory Kellogg, TekFocus COO, "we know the field will be even tougher in 2010 and TekFocus is looking forward to improving our ranking".
